Session Title: TOURISM AND GEOGRAPHY

Description of Session: Tourism is an economic activity taking place in a geographical location. The touristic attraction of any place in the world depends on both natural and human geographical characteristics. In addition, it is aimed to exchange ideas between academicians and faculty members of tourism faculties and geographical educators. Such sessions will also guide the studies of geography academicians working in the field of tourism and the research of their graduate students.
